As a team of professional experts and patients with secondary breast cancer (SBC), we help to empower people with this treatable, but incurable disease.

About Secondary Breast Cancer

It is estimated that there are 35,000 people in the UK living with secondary breast cancer and yet very few people know about the disease. With on average 1000 patients losing their life to this form of breast cancer every month, we need to make a change. It can be treated but there is no cure.



Why?

Lisa Fleming founded Make 2nds Counts on 29 May 2018 a year after her diagnosis of secondary breast cancer. She was 33 when she was diagnosed 'de novo' with secondary breast cancer. Lisa had no primary breast cancer diagnosis and it has spread to every bone in her skeleton.

“From the first day I sat in the hospital to begin a gruelling chemotherapy regime, I knew that when I felt ‘well enough’ I wanted to make a change. I wanted to raise awareness and funds to support research into secondary breast cancer. Most importantly, I wanted to ensure that people knew about the disease.”

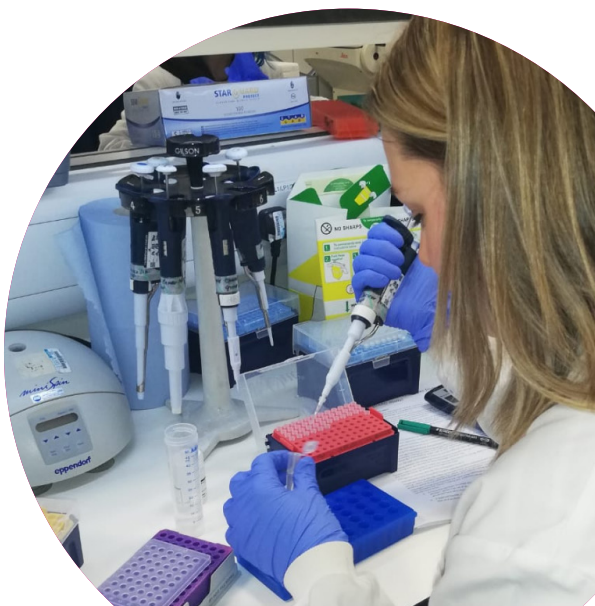
- One on one support to understand clinical trials and eligibility
