## How can the Make 2nds Count Patient Trial Advocate Nurse help?

This service is the first of its kind in the UK for patients with secondary breast cancer. The programme supports patients through education and potentially matching patients to clinical trials.

Our experienced nurses can help with questions about clinical trials, search for trials based on your eligibility and support you in discussing them with your clinician.

We want to ensure that every patient with secondary breast cancer feels empowered and has the knowledge and the opportunity to discuss trials as part of their treatment pathway.
